Coming Out of Babel!

- And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babel came in remembrance before *Elohiym*, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath. (Revelation 16:19)
 - Just what is John Mark talking about here?
 - This is the first time he mentions Babel in the Book of Revelation.
 - Why is this city so important?

Just What is Babel (Babylon)?

- Strong's # H894
- -755
- Pronounced: bâbel
- baw-bel'
- \sum KJV occurrences = 262

Just What is Babel (Babylon)?

- Strong's # H894
- -775
- Strong's Definition:
 - Babel or Babylon, the ancient site and/or capital of Babylonia (modern Hillah) situated on the Euphrates (River)
 - Babel or Babylon = "confusion (by mixing)"

Just What is Babel (Babylon)?

- Strong's # H894
- · 755
- Brown, Driver, Briggs Definition:
 - From H1101; confusion; Babel (that is, Babylon), including Babylonia and the Babylonian empire: Babel, Babylon.
 - Strong's #1101
 - לקק bâlal
 - baw-lal'
 - A primitive root; to overflow (specifically with oil); by implication to mix; also (denominative from H1098) to fodder: - anoint, confound, X fade, mingle, mix (self), give provender, temper.

Coming Out of Babel!

- 2. And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babel the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul *ruach* (spirit), and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.
- 3. For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.
- 4. And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.
- 5. For her sins have reached unto heaven, and *Elohiym* has remembered her iniquities. (Revelation 18:2-5)

- When the churches define Babel, they first use the word Babylon, then they point us to the country that destroyed the Southern Kingdom of Israel.
 - That is a good answer, but not quite the right answer.
 - Remember, the basis of every doctrine in the Bible can be found in the Torah, the first five books of the Bible.
 - The only place in the Torah that Babel is mentioned is in Genesis 11, where one of the three disasters of Genesis is enumerated.

- I) AND the whole earth was of one language, and of one speech.
- 2) And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found a plain in the land of Shin`ar; and they dwelt there.
- 3) And they said one to another, Go to, let us make brick, and burn them throughly. And they had brick for stone, and slime had they for mortar.
- 4) And they said, Go to, let us build us a city and a tower, whose top may reach unto the heavens; and let us make us a name, lest we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth. (Genesis 11:1-4)

- 5) And Yahuah came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of men built.
- 6) And Yahuah said, Behold, the people is one, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do.
- 7) Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech. (Genesis 11:5-7)

- 8) So Yahuah scattered them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: and they left off to build the city.
- 9) Therefore is the name of it called <u>Babel</u>; because Yahuah did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did Yahuah scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth. (Genesis 11:8-9)
 - It was at this point that our Heavenly Father broke up this system and scattered men abroad.
 - Isaiah and John Mark both prophesied that humanity would reach this point again in their history.

Just What is Babel and Why Should We be Concerned?

Because Babel has Returned to the Earth...

- The whole earth During the Time of Babel and Now Had:
 - I. One Language
 - Every Computer speaks one language: Assembler
 - It is the basic machine language common to all computers large or small.
 - Every computer in the world operates using this language.

2. One Speech

- Every computer communicates in this language first.
- Once it has written its speech in Assembler, then it translates its speech into human language.
- We are now starting to call this type of processing: "artificial intelligence."

Just What is Artificial Intelligence???

- The term "Artificial Intelligence" was co-coined by Drs. John McCarthy, Marvin Minsky, Nathaniel Rochester, and Claude Shannon in the summer of 1956.
- Dr. McCarthy was instrumental in the development of "servers" (he called them "time-sharing" systems) which is now morphed into "cloud computing."
- It should be noted that Dr. McCarthy was an atheist, leaving the door open for his successors to make themselves *elohim*.


Just What is Artificial Intelligence???

- Artificial Intelligence Consists of Two Components:
 - I. A Knowledge Base
 - Usually a Database of Collected Raw Data
 - Data is simple facts generated from an objective source.
 - An example would be the daily prices of a cryptocurrency, common stock, commodities, or other financial instrument.
 - 2. An Inference Engine
 - A System capable of taking objectively gathered raw data and turning that data into usable information.
 - Normally, this is some kind of calculated information.
 - Sometimes, it goes further and has decision-making capabilities.

Babel is about Substitution:

- I) they had brick for stone
 - Bricks are a complete creation of humanity.
 - Bricks rely on human computation to be laid out properly.
 - The buildings made of brick are a complete creation of man.
- 2) slime had they for mortar.
 - Mortar is the glue that keeps the bricks aligned
 - Slime is a substitute glue used by man to keep bricks together.
- Where have we read about this before?

- Babel is about Substitution:
 - 10. The bricks are fallen down, but we will build with hewn stones: the sycamores are cut down, but we will change them into cedars.
 - 11. Therefore YHWH shall set up the adversaries of Rezin against him, and join his enemies together;
 - 12. The Syrians before, and the Philistines behind; and they shall devour Israel with open mouth. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand is stretched out still. (Isaiah 9:10-12)
- The first person to discuss this chapter prophetically was Messianic Rabbi Jonathan Cahn. However, he is not the only one.



Babel is about Substitution/Mixture:

- 13. For the people turneth not unto him that smiteth them, neither do they seek YHWH of hosts.
- 14. Therefore YHWH will cut off from Israel head and tail, branch and rush, in one day.
- 15. The ancient and honorable, he is the head; and the prophet that teacheth lies, he is the tail. (Isaiah 9:13-15)

• Which is similar to:

- 17. For in one hour so great riches is come to nought. And every shipmaster, and all the company in ships, and sailors, and as many as trade by sea, stood afar off,
- 18. And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, What city is like unto this great city! (Revelation 18:17-18)

- The goal of their projects is to make man an elohim:
 - The elite think that "Artificial Intelligence" will give them the power to become *elohim*.
 - Let us build us a city and a tower,
 - Once Again, Humanity Desires to Become an Elohim.
 - For Elohim doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and <u>ye shall be like Elohim</u>, knowing good and evil. (Genesis 3:5)
 - Certain People Build a Massive System Network (the Tower) and Connects it to Millions of Subsidiary Computer Systems (the City) thinking it will make them *elohim*.

- The goal of their projects is to make man an elohim:
 - The elite think that Artificial Intelligence will give them the power to become *elohim*.
 - whose top may reach unto the heavens...
 - To make a worldwide network, they will have to put communications satellites into space that would handle the massive amount of traffic the network would demand.
 - In time, these satellites would have decision-making capabilities that would make them *elohim*-like.

- The goal of their projects is to make man an elohim:
 - The elite think that Artificial Intelligence will give them the power to become *elohim*.
 - let us make us a name
 - These major corporations will become famous which control these networks. Microsoft, Apple, Adobe, PayPal, AMD, Intel, AutoDesk, Nvidia, Comcast, Spectrum, Honeywell, just to name a few.

- The goal of their projects is to make man an elohim:
 - The elite think that Artificial Intelligence will give them the power to become *elohim*.
 - The Caveat:
 - Lest we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth.
 - The main risk would be the collapse of the satellite systems in the heavens.
 - This collapse would fragment users into small groups without any connectivity around the world.
 - This collapse would render the inventors as non-entities.

The Judgment of Babel

- And Yahuah came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of men built.
 - Yahuah watches everything we do.
- And Yahuah said, Behold, the people is one, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do.
 - When people become elohim over other people based upon the Systems they have built, they become contemptable in in the sight of Yahuah.
- Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech.
 - When man reaches that point, judgment is not far away.

- So Yahuah scattered them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: and they left off to build the city.
 - When judgment comes, the entire system will be dismantled.
- Therefore is the name of it called <u>Babel</u>; because Yahuah did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did Yahuah scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth.
 - The judgment will break the Babel system into dust and cast it all over the earth.

- Babel is more than a standard governmental system.
 - It is an automated system to manage and control people's lives.
 - To index and order every aspect of human life.
 - To allow leaders to achieve a elohim-like status in the world.
 - It is an anti-messiah system because it replaces Yahushua (Jesus) in the lives of ordinary people.
 - Every aspect of human life is governed by this system.
- So, how do we deal with this system, how do we accomplish this?
- The answer is in the Torah.
